A wonderful start to this academic year with plenty of hard work and fun learning activities taking place. The children have settled in well. A warm welcome to all our new pupils in Nursery and Reception class. Attendance and Lateness Policy

Please read our new policy on school website. No term time holidays will be authorised. Authorised absences will be considered in very rare circumstances. Please contact the school office for request form. Unauthorised absences equating to 10 days will warrant a fine issued by the Local Authority.

Lateness - School day commences at 8:55am for Reception to Year 6 and at 8:45am for Nursery. Continuous lateness will be addressed and can be quite upsetting and embarrassing for your child to enter their classroom late.
